Virtual IGF 2020: implications for NRIs (15 min)

- Due to COVID-19, IGF 2020 will be hosted online by the UN IGF 2021
 - *IGF 2021 hosted by the Government of Poland*
 - *IGF 2022 hosted by the Government of Ethiopia*
 - *IGF 2023 hosted by the Government of Japan*
- All NRIs sessions to be hosted online via Zoom
- Meeting time framework under development
- All session proposers will be asked to update proposal with plans how to carry out session implementation in an online environment

Debrief from 2nd IGF 2020 OC & MAG Meeting (15 min)

- NRIs as remote hubs for IGF 2020
- Online IGF 2020 will include **7 main sessions**:
 - *4 on thematic tracks: data, environment, inclusion, trust*
 - *1 on UN Secretary-General's Roadmap for Digital Cooperation*
 - *1 DCs session on impact of COVID-19 pandemic on work of DCs*
 - *1 NRIs session on the role of the Internet in emergency situations*
- MAG provisionally recommended **86 workshops** for its further consideration
- Youth engagement in IGF 2020 continue


Reflections on the UN Secretary-General's Roadmap for Digital Cooperation – 15 min

- Roadmap serves to respond to and builds upon the report of the High-level Panel on Digital Cooperation. The current situation of digital cooperation is assessed, including in terms of the ongoing coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic; urgent gaps and challenges are highlighted; and actions to strengthen global digital cooperation are set out.
- **Global digital cooperation:** *ideas to make the IGF more responsive and relevant to current digital issues Para 93 (d): Forging stronger links among the global Forum and its regional, national, subregional and youth initiatives.*
